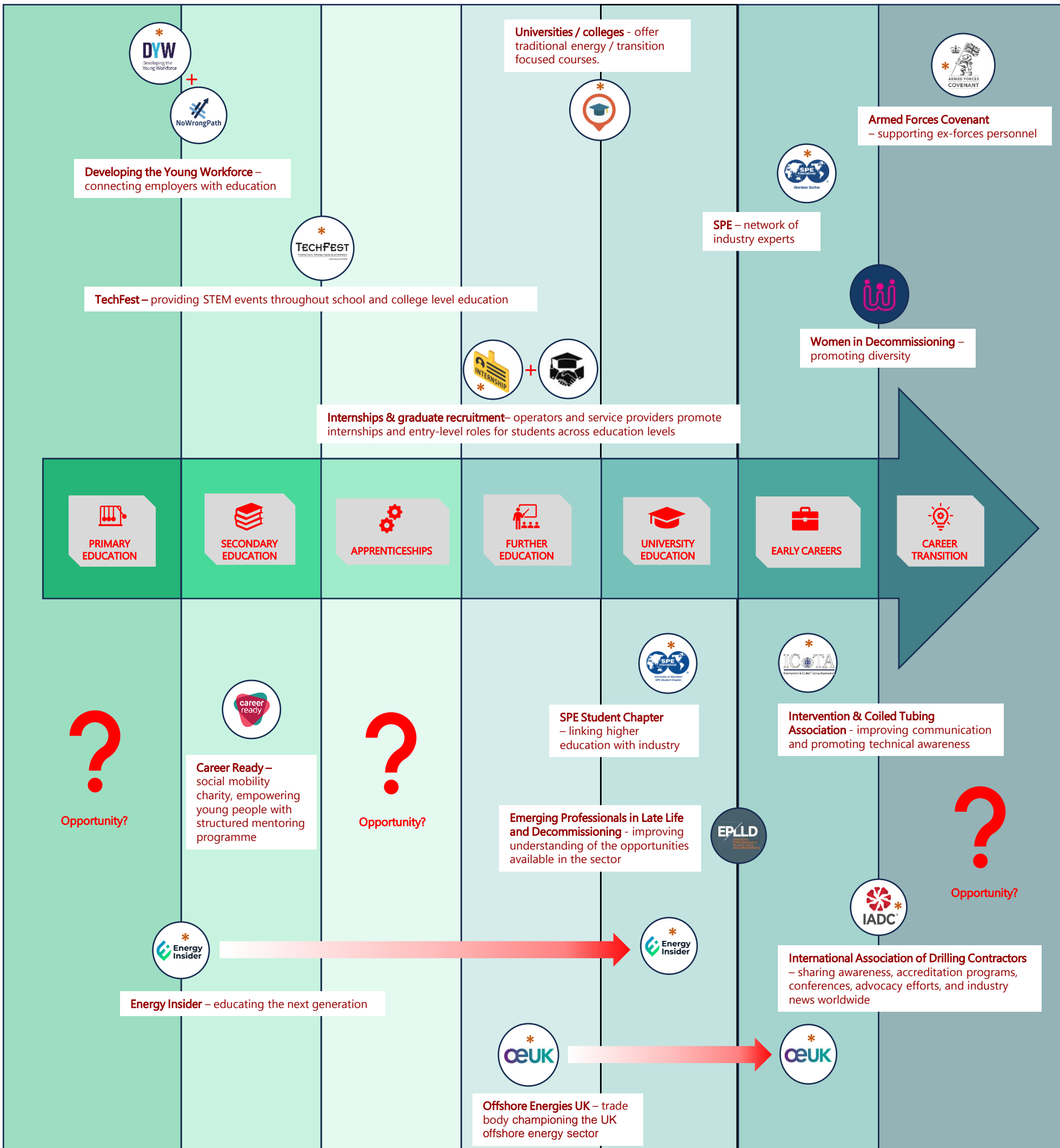


Well Decommissioning Career Initiatives in NE Scotland

The Well Decommissioning Steering Group (part of the Wells Task Force) has compiled an infographic detailing various organisations and initiatives addressing skills attraction, retention and development relating to the well decommissioning sector.
