

Oil and Gas Authority Licence (OGA Licence)

Using Information under this licence

Use of copyright and database right material expressly made available under this licence (the 'Information') indicates your acceptance of the terms and conditions below.

The OGA grants you a worldwide, royalty-free, perpetual, non-exclusive licence to use the Information subject to the conditions below.

'OGA' means the Oil and Gas Authority, a company incorporated in England and Wales (registered number 09666504) and having its registered office at 21 Bloomsbury Street, London, WC1B 3HF which owns or otherwise has the authority to offer Information under the terms of this licence.
